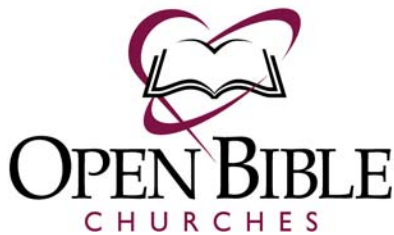


EASTERN REGION HIS ANGELS HAVE CHARGE OVER YOU



Pastor Jim Brown, from Bellbrook Community Open Bible Church in Bellbrook, Ohio, and his son, Timothy, could be dead now because of an accident on the heavily traveled, Interstate 70, in Ohio. Rejoice over God's protection as you read his account.

My son, Timothy, and I were on our way home to Dayton from Pittsburgh on Saturday, December 6th. I was driving his new Explorer for which he had not yet made the first payment. The highway was busy and there was a light snow that began to stick to the road soon after we drove into Ohio.

Approximately 3 minutes before our accident I noticed Timothy did not have his seatbelt on so, of course, I told him to put it on. We were cautiously driving in the slow lane, heading *westbound*. Then, without the slightest of warnings, the car hit ice and was flung across the westbound fast lane and into the grassy median.. We braced ourselves, because we thought we were going to hit the median barrier very hard and come to a jolting stop. I noticed an 18 wheeler and another car coming in the *eastbound* direction We did hit the median barrier, however instead of slamming and stopping we flew up over it, twisted in the air, came down and rolled at least three times (although Timothy thought it was four or five) across the *eastbound* lanes with oncoming traffic, finally coming to a jolting stop against the far, *eastbound* guardrail.



I didn't take time to pray an eloquent prayer, but I was yelling, "Jesus!" Our vehicle came to rest with the driver's side against the pavement. With the horn stuck and blaring and the smell of something burning, I said to Timothy, "Get out before this thing blows up!" The car windows had blown out so he climbed up and out, but Timothy had to help me get free as my leg was pinned between the steering column and the door.

When we were both out and safe he looked at his new car, now with pieces all over the highway, then looked at me and asked, "So do I get a new car?" It was as if God kept us in this protective little bubble through the entire accident. Not even one cut, even though I found a lot of broken glass in my jacket pockets. All we had were a couple of minor scratches, which were probably from climbing out of the vehicle. How can we not be reminded of Psalm 91:11-12. "*For He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways. In their hands they shall bear you up, lest you dash your foot against a stone.*" God is so good!!!
